REQUIREMENTS FOR

Boys

BOYS PERSONAL APPEARANCE K-8

HAIR:

No unusual “fad” cuts or hair color. Hair must be clean cut and well groomed. Must be worn above the eyebrows and may not hang below the earlobe or rest on the collar in back.

NAILS:

Must be clean and trimmed. No polish permitted.

JEWELRY:

Medical bracelets, wristwatches, and religious medals on a plain gold or silver chain permitted. No Smartwatches or earrings permitted.

BODY:

No piercings or permanent/temporary tattoos. Body must be clean of ink and marker.

BOYS APPROVED UNIFORM K-8

BELT:

Black or brown belt (no cloth)



SHOES:

Black, brown, tan, or navy standard, flat, non-marking rubber-soled, dress or saddle shoes.



SOCKS:

Navy or white (must cover the anklebone)



TIE:

Maroon plaid tie



BOYS APPROVED UNIFORM K-5

SHIRTS:

Ash gray, or cardinal red polo (short & long sleeve)
White button down collar shirt (short & long sleeve)



SHORTS:

Navy twill shorts prior to Nov. 1 and after March 31

SLACKS:

Navy twill pants year round

SWEATERS:

Navy v-neck pullover sweater
Navy vest



BOYS APPROVED UNIFORM 6-8

SHIRTS:

Ash gray, cardinal red, or navy polo (short & long sleeve)
White button down collar shirt (short & long sleeve)
Navy turtleneck



SLACKS:

Navy or khaki twill pants year round.

SHORTS:

Navy or khaki twill shorts prior to Nov. 1 and after March 31.



SWEATERS:

Cardinal red pullover sweater
Cardinal vest
Navy blazer

REQUIREMENTS FOR

Girls

GIRLS PERSONAL APPEARANCE K-8

HAIR:

No unusual “fad” cuts, hair color, hair tinsel, or hair/eyelash extensions. Hair must be well groomed. Hair accessories must coordinate with uniform.

NAILS:

Must be clean and trimmed. No false nails or polish permitted.

JEWELRY:

Medical bracelets, wristwatches, and religious medals on a plain gold or silver chain permitted. May wear small post earrings only. No smartwatches permitted.

BODY:

No piercings or permanent/temporary tattoos. Body must be clean of ink and marker. Use of makeup (including lip gloss) is not permitted.

GIRLS APPROVED UNIFORM K-8

BELT:

Black or brown belt (no cloth)



HAIR ACCESSORIES:

All hair accessories must coordinate with school uniform.



KNEE HIGH SOCKS:

Solid navy. Must be worn with skirt or jumper from Nov. 1–March 31.



TIGHTS:

Solid navy. Must be worn with skirt or jumper from Nov. 1–March 31.



SHOES:

Black, brown, tan, or navy standard, flat, non-marking rubber-soled shoes



SHORTS:

Lycra athletic style shorts must be worn under skirt or jumper.
Lycra shorts must be a dark color.



SOCKS:

Navy or white socks must cover ankle bone.



GIRLS APPROVED UNIFORM K-5

JUMPERS:

Maroon plaid drop waist jumper.

SKIRTS:

Maroon plaid 4 kick pleated skirt. Skirt hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.



SKORTS:

Navy skorts prior to Nov. 1 and after March 31. Skort hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.



SLACKS:

Navy twill pants year round.



SHIRTS:

Ash gray, or cardinal red polo (short & long sleeve)
White button down peter pan collar shirt (short & long sleeve)



SWEATERS:

Navy button-down cardigan.



GIRLS APPROVED UNIFORM 6-8

SHIRTS:

Ash gray, cardinal red, or navy polo (short & long sleeve)
White button down collar shirt (3/4 sleeve)
Navy turtleneck



SLACKS:

Khaki or navy twill pants year round.



SKIRTS:

Khaki or navy pleated skirt. Maroon plaid wrap-around kilt.
Skirt hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.



SWEATERS:

Cardinal button-down cardigan
Navy blazer

REQUIREMENTS FOR

Physical Education

P.E. APPROVED UNIFORM K-8

Must be purchased from FLYNN O'HARA or our through our spirit wear sale and it must have the SACS logo (NO SUBSTITUTIONS):

- Navy short sleeve t-shirt with school logo
- Gray short sleeve t-shirt with knight logo
- Gray or navy long-sleeve t-shirt with knight logo
- Navy shorts with school logo that are no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.

Can be worn April 1–October 31.

- Navy sweatshirt with school logo (crew neck, hoodie, or zip-up)
- Navy sweatpants with school logo. Must be worn from Nov. 1–March 31.
- White or black athletic socks covering the ankle bone
- Sneakers (no lights, characters, or wheels)

REQUIREMENTS FOR

Non-Uniform Days

K-8 APPROVED NON-UNIFORM DAYS

- All uniform personal appearance must be adhered to on Non-uniform days. No nail polish, no body art, no smart watches, no unkept hair, only approved jewelry, etc.
- Dress must be modest and in keeping with Diocesan policy.
- T-shirts must be in good taste. Nothing suggestive or offensive permitted.
- Shoes must be flat (no heels) and must have backs.
- SACS does not permit spandex shorts to be worn as shorts alone. They may only be worn underneath dresses or skirts that are no shorter than two inches above the knee. Spandex shorts must be dark in color.
- Leggings are only permitted if the top worn falls within three inches of the knee.
- Strapless or spaghetti strap tank tops are not permitted unless a sweater or cardigan is worn over the garment at all times. Shoulders may not be exposed.
- Clothing that has been cut, torn, contains holes, or excessively decorated are not permitted.
