



# WHAT TO DO IF MY CHILD IS IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT AT SCHOOL OR ELSEWHERE?

## The school will..

- excuse the student(s) from their classroom or area within the school
- provide the student with a mask as soon as possible
- take student to supervised isolation area
- notify the parent or guardian and make arrangements for student to be picked up.

## Note:

If a student has been vaccinated and s/he has come in close contact with a COVID-19 positive person, the learner does not need to quarantine; however, the child should take a COVID test five days after last exposure to the positive individual. The school principal should be notified if the child develops symptoms during this time. Giving proof of vaccination status is a personal choice, but a copy is required if the child is to be excused from quarantine. Vaccination cards will be kept confidential in the student's medical records.

## The Parent/Guardian needs to...

- arrange pick up of student(s)
- monitor the child/ren's symptoms
- email Mrs. Salmon at [lsalmon@saintandrewschool.org](mailto:lsalmon@saintandrewschool.org) if their child/dren begin to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19.



**Student(s) begins quarantine at home.**



**Student(s) can return to school and end quarantine once the following criteria are met...**

- 7 days out from last exposure with negative COVID-19 test, **OR**
- 10 days out from last exposure, **AND**
- Fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, **AND**
- Symptoms have improved.
