



# WHAT TO DO IF MY CHILD BECOMES COVID-19 POSITIVE?

## The parent/guardian needs to...

- notify Mrs. Salmon by email (lsalmon@saintandrewschool.org).
- provide a list of symptoms exhibited by child/children
- know the date of the onset of symptoms.



**Student(s) and siblings begin isolation at home.**



**The ill student(s) can return to school and end isolation once the following criteria are met...**

- 10 days out from the onset of symptoms, **AND**
- Fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, **AND**
- Symptoms have improved.

## The school principal or liaison will...

- identify "close contacts"
- notify local health officials
- notify all families of students identified as "close contacts"
- notify the school community of a positive case
- ensure that areas occupied by the ill student are cleaned and disinfected.
- ensure classrooms are well ventilated.

## Note:

Siblings that ***do not*** develop symptoms during the initial 10 day isolation period should contact Mrs. Salmon to discuss family specific scenarios along with a timeline for a return date.
