



# WHAT TO DO IF MY CHILD IS LIVES WITH A COVID-19 POSITIVE INDIVIDUAL?

## The school will..


- excuse the student(s) from their classroom or area within the school
- take student to supervised isolation area
- make arrangements with the parents for student(s) to be picked up.

## Note:

If a student has been vaccinated and s/he has come in close contact with a COVID-19 positive person, the learner does not need to quarantine; however, must take a COVID test 5 days after last exposure. The school principal should be notified if the child develops symptoms during this time. Giving proof of vaccination status is a personal choice, but a copy is required if the child is to be excused from quarantine. Vaccination cards will be kept confidential in the student's medical records.

## The Parent/Guardian needs to...

- arrange pick up of students
- monitor the child/ren's symptoms
- email Mrs. Salmon at [lsalmon@saintandrewschool.org](mailto:lsalmon@saintandrewschool.org) if their child/dren begins to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19.



**Student(s) begins quarantine at home. The COVID-19 positive individual should isolate away from the rest of the family (if feasible).**



**Student(s) can return to school and end quarantine once the following criteria are met...**

- 7 days out from last exposure with negative COVID-19 test, **OR**
- 10 days out from last exposure, **AND**
- Fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication, **AND**
- Symptoms have improved.
